

BYLAW #13:2010

**A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF IRRICANA IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA
TO AMEND BYLAW #13:2003 TO PROVIDE THE LICENSING, REGULATING
AND CONFINEMENT OF ANIMALS**

WHEREAS the *Municipal Government Act*, RSA 2000, c.M.26 provides for the regulating of domestic animals; the Council of the Town of Irricana, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

WHEREAS the Council deems it favourable to provide for the fair and efficient regulation of animals occurring within the Town of Irricana; and

WHEREAS the Council deems it necessary to amend Bylaw No. 13:2003, the existing "Animal Bylaw"; and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF IRRICANA, DULY ASSEMBLED, HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Section 7, Subsection j) of Bylaw No. 13:2003 be deleted:

2. That Section 7, Subsection d) of Bylaw No. 13:2003 be amended to:

If a dog or animal defecates on any property that is not the owner's property, the owner shall remove such defecation and dispose of same in a sanitary manner, and failure to do so means that the owner is guilty of an offence.
