

Municipal Ticketing Bylaw

018-2018

Whereas the Provincial Courts will no longer adjudicate Municipally issued tickets, and the Town of Irricana requires a ticketing procedure to allow for local enforcement, the Town of Irricana hereby enacts this Bylaw.

- 1) Any ticket issued under this or any other Bylaw must be issued in accordance with the Bylaw Enforcement Bylaw 09-2018.
- 2) Tickets may be issued by a Bylaw Officer or the CAO only.
- 3) All tickets issued by the Town for Bylaw infractions are owed to the Town and are payable at the Town Office.
- 4) All tickets issued must be paid within 30 days of the date of issue on the ticket.
- 5) Any issued ticket may be disputed. If the ticket is to be disputed, the person issued the ticket must notify the CAO in person or by email to cao@irricana.com that they wish to dispute the ticket within 14 days of the date of issue on the ticket. The dispute will be placed on the Agenda for the next regularly scheduled Town Council meeting. Town Council will hear the objection to the ticket in a Closed Session (non-public) portion of the meeting.
- 6) The decision of Town Council will be final, although any person may take their complaint to a Court of Competent Jurisdiction.
- 7) Any unpaid ticket will be added to the property taxes owed to the Town.
- 8) A municipal ticket may be issued to a rental tenant, rather than a property owner. If such a ticket is issued, the property owner will also be notified of the ticket within 48 hours of the issuance. Any ticket issued to a tenant that remains unpaid will be added to the property taxes of the Registered Land Owner. It is the responsibility of the Land Owner to recover the ticket cost from their tenant.
- 9) This Bylaw has no effect or bearing on tickets issued under any Legislation other than Town of Irricana Bylaws.


