DEVELOPMENT PERMIT

Approval Condition(s) OR Reason(s) for Refusal

Scope of Approval

- 1. This approval is limited to the addition of liquor sales within the existing retail store premises. No enlargement, exterior alteration, or separate public entrance is approved under this permit.
- The liquor area shall be constructed in accordance with the floorplan and elevations submitted.
 Minor deviations for constructability purposes are approved subject to the satisfaction of the
 Development Authority.

Operational Requirements

- 3. Customer access to the liquor area shall be through the main retail space only.
- 4. The liquor area shall remain under staff supervision at all times when open to the public.
- 5. All liquor storage, including overstock, shall be contained within the liquor room or existing backroom storage areas.
- 6. The business must maintain a valid Town of Irricana business license at all times.

Regulatory Approvals

- 7. The Applicant shall obtain and maintain all required provincial approvals and licensing from the Alberta Gaming, Liquor and Cannabis Commission (AGLC). Evidence of AGLC approval shall be provided to the Development Authority prior to commencing liquor sales.
- 8. All construction and operation must meet the requirements of the *Alberta Building Code*, *Alberta Fire Code*, and the *Safety Codes Act*. The Applicant shall provide satisfactory evidence of compliance to the Development Authority before liquor sales begin.

Signage and Advertising

9. Any liquor-related signage (including window decals, fascia, or exterior signs) must comply with Land Use Bylaw requirements. Signage may be added under this approval but requires approval from the Development Authority prior to installation.
