

2026 Town of Irricana Property Taxes

The amount due is shown on the line **Total Current Taxes Payable for 2026** and includes:

Provincial Taxes & Levies:	Amounts collected on behalf of the Province of Alberta.
Municipal Taxes & Levies:	Amounts collected by the municipality to support local operations, services, and infrastructure.
External Taxes & Levies:	Amounts collected on behalf of regional and external agencies.
Current Outstanding Balance:	Unpaid taxes from previous year(s) and / or account delinquencies (e.g. utility arrears) transferred to the property tax roll in accordance with municipal bylaws and provincial legislation.

2026 Property Taxes are due by June 30th, 2026.

- Payments made on or after May 28, 2026 may not be reflected on this Property Tax Notice.
- Unpaid balances are subject to penalties in accordance with the Tax Penalty Bylaw (Bylaw 007:2022).

Payment Options:

Payment(s) can be made by:

- Visiting the Town Office during business hours (Debit*, Cash**, or Cheque).
- Using the after-hours payment drop box located at the Town Office (Cheques only please).
- Mailing payment by cheque. Mailed payments must be postmarked on or before the due date.
- Using online or telephone banking through your financial institution.
- Sending payment by e-transfer to irricana@irricana.com.

** Please confirm your daily transaction limit prior to attempting payment.*

*** Please note that limited cash is available to make change.*

If your property taxes are paid through a financial institution, a copy of the 2026 Property Tax Notice has been provided to them on your behalf.

2027 Prepayment Options

Prepayments for 2027 Property Taxes may be made once 2026 Property Taxes have been paid in full. The Town offers a Tax Installment Payment Plan (TIPP) for those who prefer to pay property taxes through monthly installments.

Payments are automatically withdrawn on the first day of each month, with no additional fees or interest charges for participating. TIPP provides a convenient, no-cost option to help spread property tax payments throughout the year.

Prepayments may also be made by Debit, Cash, or Cheque (post-dated cheques are not accepted), or through online or telephone banking. All prepayments are automatically credited to the property tax account.
