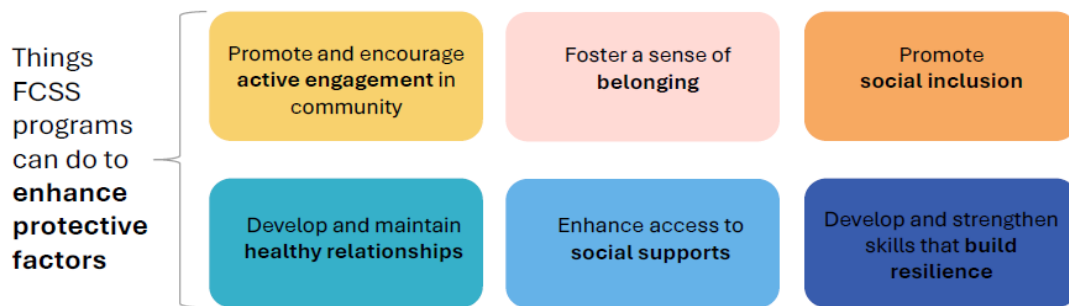

Type of Prevention

<p>Primary prevention focuses on the general population or on subsets of the population who may be at higher risk with the intent of promoting protective factors in the physical or social environment</p> <p>FCSS Services</p>	<p>Primary Prevention</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Address root causes of social issues with focus on the general population or a specific population • Promote protective factors in the physical and social environment (including social relationships) • Can include awareness programs, enhancing connections among community organizations and promoting community volunteerism
<p>Secondary prevention focuses on specific groups or at-risk populations to address issues at an early stage</p>	<p>Secondary Prevention</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Address issues at an early stage for specific groups or at-risk populations • Strengthen the capacity of individuals and communities to prevent or reduce risk factors and build resilience • Can include connecting those in need with appropriate resources and skill development
<p>Additional services permitted only during a public health emergency or extenuating circumstance, as determined by the Minister</p>	<p>Tertiary Prevention</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Address immediate needs with intent to prevent long-term impacts • Support individuals or groups already affected by social issues by providing direct services • Can include direct assistance such as food and shelter
