✓ ACCEPTED

- Bagged household garbage
- Food wrappers & chip bags
- Styrofoam packaging
- Diapers & hygiene products
- Pet waste (bagged)
- Broken non-recyclable items

✗ NOT ACCEPTED

- Liquids
- Paint & chemicals
- Batteries
- Electronics
- Construction debris
- Items preventing lid closure
- Propane tanks



BLUE CART RECYCLING

✓ ACCEPTED

- Paper & cardboard
- Newspapers & flyers
- Plastic bottles & jugs
- Plastic tubs & lids
- Metal food cans
- Aluminum foil
- Glass bottles & jars
- Cartons

✗ NOT ACCEPTED

- Food residue
- Plastic bags
- Film wrap
- Styrofoam
- Hoses & cords
- Electronics
- Ceramics
- Mirrors
- Light bulbs
- Contaminated waste



RECYCLING TIP



Keep items empty, clean, and dry.



Flatten cardboard.



Do not bag recycling.

CART PLACEMENT

Please place your carts correctly to help ensure safe and efficient collection for everyone.



1 METRE
from vehicles



1 METRE
between carts



Set carts out by 7:00 AM on your collection day.

SET OUT YOUR CARTS CORRECTLY

Face carts toward the street or alley.



Keep carts away from fences and mailboxes.



Place carts on level ground.



Do not overfill carts. Lid must close.



Return carts to your property after collection.



COLLECTION MAY BE MISSED IF:

- Lid does not close
- Cart blocked by vehicle
- Cart buried in snow
- Hazardous or contaminated waste present
- Materials protruding from cart
